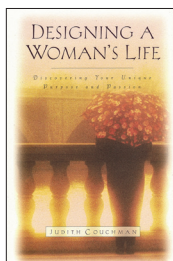

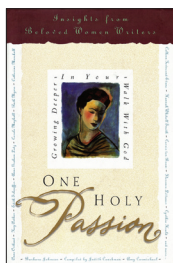

Designing a Woman's Life



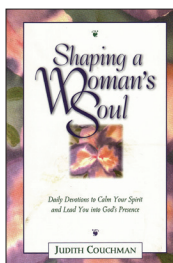

One Holy Passion



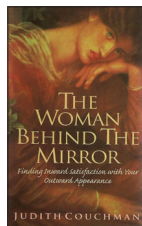

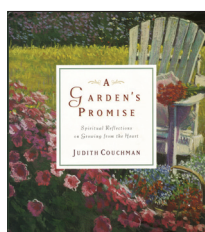
The Woman Behind the Mirror

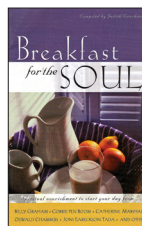

A Garden's Promise



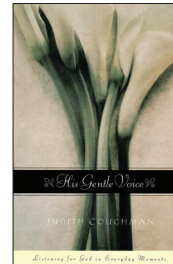

Breakfast for the Soul



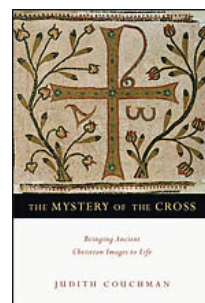

His Gentle Voice



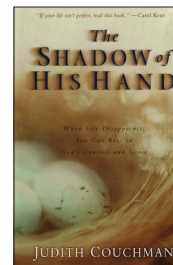

The Shadow of His Hand

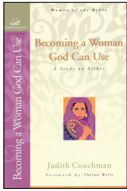

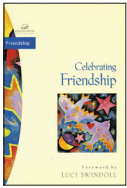

Becoming a Woman God Can Use (Esther)



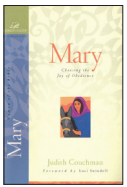

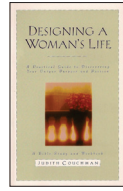
Choosing the Joy of Obedience (Mary)

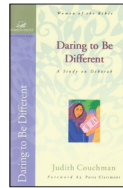

Designing a Woman's Life Bible Study and Workbook



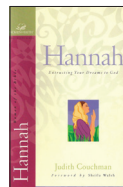
